The text are mostly interviews with the designers. All the labels pointing to the drawings are also translated so you can now make sense of what's what. As an artist/graphic designer, this book contains images that inspire and even help in the process of creating a monster. It also has intricate art on character, armor designs and weapon designs. I was actually expecting it in Japanese, but its in English making it more interesting to read, since the artists of the game speak about how they had to design the monsters and weapons. It also contains a black and white section (my favorite part of the book) with preliminary sketches and even designs that never made it into the game.Definitely a must have for any collector, artist and Monster Hunter fan!!
