If you are a beginner do not buy this book. It serves only to confuse. The tab examples of the scales presented in this book are atrocious. They would probably make more sense if the author told you what scale he is presenting. They do not line up with any of the scale diagrams. He is clearing going for diagram 1 but false to clearly explain the scales position. The scale examples move up the neck in five diagrams yet the author fails to indicate the fret number each diagram starts on. Again if you

are a beginner do not buy this book it will only serve to discourage. If you are not a beginner continue to shop around there are better books out there. The one stars are for the lack of explanation. I have been playing bass for twenty years and I have to say this book could have been written better.

Simple. I took off a star because I think that it is a bit over priced for what it is. Nothing mentioned really about hand positioning, etc., while playing the scales. It just lists a bunch of things that you can easily find on the internet for free. It is nice to have it all assembled for you, so it certainly is worth something, but still, I feel that it is a little over priced.
